Its' smoothness makes it surprisingly pleasant, though avoiding excesses. Captivating.		
Authentic Lambrusco is made from a family of ancient indigenous varieties the Romans called "Vitis Labrusca," a Latin phrase meaning "wild vine." Lambrusco wines range from dry to sweet & while most are dark ruby red in color, there are also whites & rosés. All of them compliment the rich, hearty foods of Emilia-Romagna, namely rich pasta sauces like Bolognese as well as dry cured salumi & formaggi; the bubbles, light tannins & crisp acidity cleanse the palate with every sip. The sweeter ones are great with chocolate desserts.

100% VERDICCHIO. "Straw-yellow. Intense nose of apricot and peach with marine mineral undertones. The same fruit fabric recurs on the palate with lovely substance lifted by restrained exuberance and a balanced creamy texture. Delicious and direct." - 89 pts., Gilbert & Gaillard

PIERRE FERRAND COGNAC

The vines that give Pierre Ferrand its distinctive style are planted on the Angeac terroir in the heart of Grande Champagne, considered the Premier Cru de Cognac. The extremely chalky soil of the rolling landscape gives the grapes the qualities and the necessary acidity to make very good wines that will produce very fine cognacs. Pierre Ferrand cognacs are distilled slowly, in small pot stills then aged on the original wine's unfiltered lees. Particularly rich in fruit aromas, the lees help to give the raw spirit body and flavor, elements that will mature as they are aged in small oak barrels. After years of aging, cellar masters practice the subtle and precise art of blending, passed on through five generations to create an incomparable cognac.

GRAPPA

Grappa's qualities depend not only on the skill of the winemaker, but even more on the skill and care of the distiller. To gain any level of depth and complexity from grappa, the pomace from which it is made, must be of very high quality. The grapes & wines of both Banfi in Tuscany & by Marchesi di Gresy in Piedmont are of a very high grade, grown and vinified under some of the tightest production restrictions of any D.O.C.G. Using the right balance of patience and skill, this quality has been carried through to their final use. Enjoy grappa simply on its own, after dinner or to an espresso for a perfect caffè corretto.
